Spring from the Box

Our next show will be held at the **Black Box Gallery** in Dearborn in April. This is our first-ever show using only electronic entries, BUT DON'T PANIC! Many of our members have entered shows electronically, and some are available to help. Here is what you need to know going forward:

A link on our website, **DSWPS.org**, will take you to the submission form at **EntryThingy.com** (don't blame me, I didn't choose the name...) Once there:

- 1. Log in if you have an EntryThingy account. If you don't have one, click on "Click here to sign up," set up an account, and log in.
- 2. At the top of the next page you'll see the name of our show.
- 3. Beside the name of the show, click the button saying "Apply now."
- 4. This brings you to our entry form. Fill it out right there on the computer.
- 5. It will ask you to choose one of the payment options You can use either a credit card or, if you have one, a Paypal account.
- 6. Once your payment is received, your entry is submitted. You'll receive an email confirming this.

What to do if you are stuck:

- Call a computer-savvy friend for help.
- Sign up for one of the help sessions that DSWPS will sponsor in January:
