President Kathy O'Connell called the meeting to order a 11:20 am. There were thirty-seven members in attendance at the Detroit Yacht Club.

March Minutes: President O'Connell asked that the minutes of the Recording Secretary Carolyn Sherwood be accepted as published in the newsletter. There were no objections.

Treasurer Marilyn Bomarito reported a starting balance and the ending balance as of March 31, 2016. A motion to receive and file was made by Carolyn Sherwood and was supported by Joyce Manke.

Corresponding Secretary Joyce Manke informed membership of a competition for a mural design sent to her by Tracy Irwin. There will be an "email blast" with more details.
