## Minutes of General Meeting - May 16, 2017 Down River Council for the Arts

**President Jackie Rybinson** called the meeting to order at 11:20 am. Thirty two members signed the attendance sheet. New members were asked to introduce themselves.

The minutes of the April meeting were approved with a correction of membership total to 144. The motion to approve the minutes as corrected was made by Paula Wild with support from Bette Prudden.

**First Vice President Programs Chris Unwin** reported that the September 21, 2017 meeting would be held at the **Detroit Yacht Club.** This is also the date that work will be juried for the **Starkweather Art Center** show.

**Second Vice President Exhibitions Deborah Benedic** reported that Jan Filarski would be the show coordinator for the Starkweather Art Center exhibition. Intake for jurying will be at the September meeting at DYC beginning at 9:30 am and ending at 10:45 am.

Accepted work should be delivered to the Starkweather Art Center on Saturday, September 30 from 10 am - 4 pm. The juror is Kim Fay. The opening reception will be Saturday, October 8, 2017 from 1 -3 pm.

After giving her report Deb Benedic informed the membership that due to family concerns, she regretfully needed to step down from her position as Senior VP Exhibitions. Deb asked that anyone interested in completing the last year of her term please contact her or the President. The Second VP Exhibitions determines the exhibition site and date, the show coordinator handles the details of the specific exhibition.

**Third Vice President Directory and Membership Chair Jan Ducsay** reported a current membership of 143. Eighty members have already renewed as of May 16. Virginia Jaeger, who lives in Grand Rapids wrote a letter of appreciation to the organization as she conveyed her decision to discontinue her membership.

**Historian Julie Sabit** advised the membership that the resumé book would be at the Downriver Council for the Arts show. During her rehab after surgery, Carolyn Sherwood will assist with Historian duties. Kathleen McNamee will add the resumé form to the website.

Jackie Rybinski, Jan Ducsay and Kathleen McNamee will go to the Burton Collection at the Detroit Main Library to begin the preliminary stages of compiling DSWPS history since the 1950's.

**Scholarship Committee Chair Marilyn Bomarito** opened the discussion to expand the scholarship award search to students from Detroit area institutions. The scholarship committee has removed the 'lifelong Michigan resident' restriction from the Scholarship requirements. The motion to choose the 2017-2018 scholarship recipient from Wayne State University was made by Marilyn Bomarito with support from Kathleen McNamee. Motion carried.

**Webmaster Kathleen McNamee** asked that membership send her information for DSWPS website.

The meeting adjourned at 12;13 pm.
