Thank you Marilyn Bomarito for coordinating "Artistic Endeavors" with Jean Peacock at the DCA, while keeping up with your responsibilities as Treasurer and Scholarship Committee Chairwoman.

I want to thank our wonderful board members, especially Joyce Manke (newsletter) and Carolyn Sherwood (Recording Secretary) who never fail. Carolyn also initiated and implemented five drop-in workshops at the Mike Kelley's Mobile Homestead. Emily Beadle had an open studio there too. Deb Benedic took on our 2nd VP (Exhibitions) and coordinated two shows: "Recent Works" at the Loft Gallery and the "Home" show at MKMH with Tracy Irwin (both women manage art/history galleries full time). We had a continuous stream of young art lovers visiting the "Home" show. The resulting publicity was well worth their efforts.
