Minutes of General Meeting, November 17, 2016 - West Bloomfield Twp. Library

President Jackie Rybinski called the meeting to order at 11:38 am. Twenty-two members and guests were in attendance at the West Bloomfield Twp. Library.

Recording Secretary Carolyn Sherwood read the minutes of the September meeting. There was no formal October meeting. The motion to accept the minutes as read was made by Jan Ducsay, supported by Kathleen McNamee. Motion carried.

Treasurer Marilyn Bomarito reported following account balances: August 31, 2016, September 30, 2016, October 31, 2016. The motion to receive and file the report was made by Joyce Manke with support from Arlene Oakland. Motion carried.

Corresponding Secretary Joyce Manke stated that she would send an email blast to membership regarding any changes to the December luncheon dates.

First VP Programs Chris Unwin informed those in attendance that Jennifer Fitzpatrick, instructor at College for Creative Studies and Birmingham Bloomfield Art Center, would speak on the psychology of what we paint.

The December luncheon will take place on the ninth at the Dearborn Country Club.

The February meeting will be at Detroit Yacht Club.

Second VP Exhibitions Deborah Benedic: Jackie Rybinski gave a brief history behind the **Kelly Homestead at MOCAD.** DSWPS will exhibit there February 3 through May 11, 2017. Deborah Benedic and Tracy Irwin are co-chairs. The juror is Dominic Pangborn. Applications for entry should be in by January 14; the jurying will take place at the Homestead on January 26 from 10 am until Noon. The theme of the exhibition is "Home." MOCAD is providing postcards, tours of the Homestead, and information on their website about the exhibit and programs DSWPS is offering.

Tracy informed the members that she started discussions with MOCAD about a year ago. Mike Kelly had written in his journal he envisioned a group like a watercolor society using the space that he created. MOCAD was looking for a small community organization that would fulfill Mike Kelly's vision for his House. DSWPS met that description. As co-chair, Tracy Irwin is in charge of scheduling activities at the Homestead during our approximately three months there. Carolyn Sherwood spoke about activities that she planned to conduct, four printmaking weekends and one free painting weekend.

Deb Maiale offered to share some activities that she used as an art teacher. Members should email Tracy Irwin if they are interested in doing a demonstration or conducting a workshop.

Marilyn Bomarito is chair of the **Downriver Council of Arts show** scheduled for May, 2017. Jurying will take place May 16 and the show will be hung on May 17. The reception has been planned for May 18. Jan Filarski is the chair for the **Starkweather Gallery exhibit** October, 2017.

Third VP Directory Jan Ducsay reported that the cost for 200 copies of the 2016-2017 Directory came in under budget by \$72.13.

Membership Chair Jan Ducsay reported four new members and one reinstatement. The current membership is 146.

Webmaster Kathleen McNamee thanked Jan Ducsay for the photos from The Crooked Tree Gallery show which she downloaded to the website. Members should send photos of their work to add to the website.

The meeting adjourned at 12:28 pm. Joyce Manke made the motion to adjourn. She was supported by Deborah Maiale.
