- \* Publicity Chair



# **Detroit Society of Women Painters & Sculptors General Meeting Minutes - November 14, 2018**

**President Joan Smykowski** called the meeting to order at 11:15. Forty members were in attendance at the Scarab Club.

**Membership Jan Ducsay** reported that the membership is now at 140.

**Deb Benedict** read the minutes she recorded at the October meeting as Carolyn Sherwood could not attend the October or November meeting because of ill health. Carolyn has asked that someone take her place during her illness and is planning the 2018-2019 will be her last year as Recording Secretary.

**Deb Benedict** also reported that in trying to connect DSWPS with the Global Art Project for Peace, she has run into some snags. It doesn't look like we will participate this year. She will continue to investigate, perhaps creating a project just for DSWPS since she personally has artist contacts around the world.

**Programs Jackie Rybinski** reported that the Holiday Tea at the Whitney has space for member guests.

Treasurer Marilyn Bomarito reported an October 2018 balance.

**Exhibitions Erica Chappuis** introduced a survey regarding "acceptable media" exhibitions. Those in attendance expressed a general acceptance of any media, including photography, digital art, and alternative materials. She will have the survey published in the newsletter.

Erica also reported that our old Facebook page will be taken down and a new Facebook page that allows only comments and information of interest to DSWPS has been started. Erica will be monitoring the page for DSWPS.

**Webmaster Kathy McNamee** reported that DSWPS is ready to go digital. *Entrythingy* is essentially set up and will be ready for the April Show at the Black Box in Dearborn. It was suggested that those members familiar with digital entry offer to assist members who are unfamiliar.

**Directory Jan Ducsay** pointed out that the Society has not named an Honorary Member for some years. She suggested that the membership review the process and qualifications in the Bylaws, Article 1 Membership and Dues, printed in the directory. Further, Jan suggested that the members submit nominations to the Executive Board so that Honorary members can be elected at the next Annual Meeting in May 2019. The procedure for nominations will be printed in the newsletter and website.

**President Joan Smykowski** informed the membership that Shirley Hathaway is in poor health and has had to resign at publicity chair.
