# DETROIT SOCIETY OF WOMEN PAINTERS AND SCULPTORS Minutes of General Meeting, May 19, 2016 - Detroit Yacht Club

**President Kathy O'Connell** called the meeting to order at 11:09 am. Forty-one members and guests present at the Detroit Yacht Club signed the attendance sheet.

**Recording Secretary Carolyn Sherwood** read the minutes of the April meeting. The report of the membership chair was omitted in the April minutes. Carolyn Sherwood asked that the minutes of the April meeting be accepted as amended with the inclusion of the following report: "Membership Chair Jan Ducsay asked that new members introduce themselves. Three new members and one renewal have brought membership to 153. Those members planning to have work exhibited at Anton Art Center were reminded that 2016-2017 dues must be current." Mariellen Walker made the motion to accept the minutes as amended. She was supported by Beverly Dinsmore. Motion carried.

**Corresponding Secretary Joyce Manke** asked that all information to be placed in the newsletter be sent to her before the last week of the month. Photos are welcomed. There will be a July-August newsletter during the summer. The September meeting will be on the fourth Thursday, September 22, due to the Petoskey Show art delivery date.

**Treasurer Marilyn Bomarito** reported a starting balance of \$7,455.29. As of April 30, 2016 the balance was \$8,106.28.

**Second VP Exhibitions Jackie Rybinski** announced that Deborah Benedic had volunteered to fill the slate as Second VP Exhibitions 2016-2018. General questions were answered regarding the Petoskey Show. Detailed information will be in the June newsletter. It was suggested that **Costco** be looked into as a source for free packing cardboard. Jackie reported to the membership that Arlene Oakland would visit J. Charach Gallery to follow up on Carol LaChiusa's initial contact with the gallery. Carolyn Sherwood will develop a children's program of activities that will be presented to MOCAD if Tracy Irwin pursues the Kelly Homestead Project. There was some question concerning over-sized work. Deborah Benedic offered to inquire about the possibility of one large piece instead of two pieces within the size restrictions.

Third VP Directory Arlene Oakland distributed 2014-2015 directories to new members.

**Historian Julie Sabit** had resume forms available for those artists who as yet had not contributed an artist statement and photo(s) to the Resume Book.

### STANDING COMMITTEES

**Membership Jan Ducsay** reported a current membership of 155. One hundred one renewals have already been sent in for 2016-2017. Only those members who have paid dues by June 30 will be in the 2016-2017 Directory. Guests were welcomed.

**Publicity Chair Shirley Hathaway** informed the membership that The Crooked Tree Gallery would handle publicity for the show. She asked that information sent to her allow for a three to four week lead time as required by local newspapers and HOUR magazine.

**Scholarship Chair Marilyn Bomarito** introduced Sarah Craven, the 2016 scholarship recipient from College for Creative Studies. She will present her work after lunch.

**Memorial Chair Jean Thomas** notified the membership of the death of Elizabeth Yorgen, long-time member and former president of the organization. A donation of \$50.00 will be sent to Berkley Library in her memory. Jean also stated that there would be a \$100.00 Elizabeth Yorgen Memorial Award presented at the Anton Art Center show.

**Nominating Committee Co-chair Carolyn Sherwood** informed the membership that Co-chair Marilyn Bomarito would take over the election of the slate of officers at the annual meeting.

**Committee Chair of Global Art Project Carol LaChiusa** reported that Beverly Zimmerman had sent the art package to the reciprocating artists in England. We will receive art work in return at the September, 2016 meeting. The Project Administrators made the decision that they would only accept the original number of pieces that were reported within the timeline set by the Global Art Project organization.

The meeting adjourned at 11:52 am.
