The Petoskey Crooked Tree Art Center "Soliloquy" Exhibit looks terrific. Sheila Ruen's work hanging, and especially the lighting, really showed everyone's work at its best. I have a few members helping with the return of artwork in November: Anna Hughes, Martine MacDonald, Rebecca Hauschild, Kathy O'Connell and Janet Kondziela. I will store the artwork at my home for those unable to pickup because of holiday plans.

The CTAC "Coffee at 10" program Oct. 18 was fun. I had a great time, and I want to thank Linda Allen, Lori Zurvalec and her husband David Hands, for coming to see my presentation of DSWPS History and Connections to Detroit Art Institutions. The presentation was based on information I collected for our retrospective at the Detroit Historical Museum in 2014. They made some valuable suggestions to add to the project, which is a work in progress. A big part will be adding more information about our members after 1953. (That was the year Julia Gatlin Moore published the <u>History of the Detroit Society of Women</u> Painters and Sculptors - 1903-1953.) I will be combing though our archives at the DPL Burton Collection again, but I need your help: I would appreciate information about members. especially those who made important contributions to the Society and the art world in late 20th century. MOCAD is on Woodward Ave. and Garfield, a few blocks south of the DIA. There is space for one or more members to use a portion of the gallery as a FREE studio and sales area.


